
Our Whakapapa - Our Story

Mairangi Bay School was established in 1967. It is located in a coastal suburb of North Shore. Auckland, in the North Island of New Zealand. In the early 1960s, families began spending time on holiday on the North Shore and eventually stayed in the area for a life of prosperity. Positioned on the south-east-facing peninsula forming the northern side of the Waitematā Harbour, the school was a temporary build in response to the growing population. Over half a century later, the school continues to serve the akonga from Years 1 to 6, embracing a multicultural demographic. In time, our school has become part of the heart of our community.

Mairangi is of Te Reo origin and means "Welcoming sun". When gifted as a name, the child is promised a life of prosperity and perfection. This is why a person from Mairangi Bay has a high chance of being lucky, likeable, well-tempered and possibly blessed.

Our school has an inclusive and supportive culture. It feels warm and magical - a place learners genuinely belong. Working in partnership, teachers, students, and whānau, the school cultivates a learning community by building and maintaining relationships through the school values of kindness, respect, and resilience. The staff embrace manaakitanga (care) and whanaungatanga (home-school partnership) through kotahitanga (unity).
